

Heartland Limousin Association Regional Show June 5-6

The 2009 Heartland Limousin Association Junior Regional Show will be held June 5-6 at the Franklin County Fairgrounds in Ottawa, Kansas. The entry fee of \$25 per head and is due by May 1st. Cattle may arrive on Thursday, June 4; however, they must remain in tie-outs. Check-in will begin at noon on Friday, June 5th followed by a junior meeting, activities and mixers.

This is a “come-as-you-are” event and we hope to see everyone on Friday for the junior activities and meal. The show will begin at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 6th with the steer show, bulls, bred & owned bulls, bred & owned females, bred & owned Lim-Flex, Limousin females, best pair of females and showmanship. The HLA show will follow the NALJA rules on fitting – the use of adhesives is optional.
