

Wulf Cattle Holds “Opportunity Sale of 2017” at End of March

The Wulf Cattle “Opportunity Sale of 2017” was held on March 31, 2017 at the farm near Morris, Minnesota. The video format provided for a fast moving sale of 315 Limousin bulls, and 26 females plus 25 Angus bulls and 13 females. When the final gavel came down, the sale totaled \$2,185,460.

Breeders from all over the United States, Canada, and Australia gathered for the sale. The two-day event began with a seminar on night of March 30th, featuring a program on Beef Quality Assurance.

The top-selling bull was Wulf’s Defend K909D ET, a 2/27/16 red, homozygous polled purebred son of Wulfs Xtractor out of Wulfs Worth It All 9108W. Rob Brawner, Bullis Creek Ranch of Wood Lake, Nebraska held the final bid of \$20,000.

Wulfs Compadre 2033C, an 8/28/15 red, homozygous polled purebred son of Wulfs Zane X238Z out of Wulfs Zandy 2033Z was purchased by a syndicate of breeders including KS Limousin of Java Village, NY, Beach Limousin of Bristol, OK, Ochsner Limousin of Kersey, CO, Fillmore Ranch of Boone, CO, Bachmeier Limousin of Apple Valley, MN and J Bar J Limousin of Lebanon, MO for \$19,500.

Wulfs Conversion 3970C, an 8/22/15 homozygous black, homozygous polled purebred son RUNL Stetson 850S out of TMCK Lantern 070A was purchased by Ben Petre and Caleb Miller, BCV Farms of Mt. Perry, Ohio for \$16,000.

Wulfs Command K136C ET, an 8/29/15 black, homozygous polled purebred son of Wulfs Yankee K689Y out of Wulfs Shooting Star 6134S was purchased by Pinnacle View Farms of Quesnel, British Columbia.

Wulfs Donegal U371D, a 2/19/15 black, homozygous polled purebred son of Wulfs Xclusive 2458X out of TMCK 541Z was purchased by Greg Smith of Marion, North Dakota for \$11,000.

Dave and Brenda Meyers of Flasher, North Dakota were the volume buyers of 40 Wulf bulls. Jeff Wiersma, J2 Cattle Co. of Outlook, Washington purchased 30 bulls from the Wulf offering.

Patrick Capps of Casper, Wyoming purchased the high-selling Limousin heifer, Wulfs Demi Moore 6192D, a 3/21/16 red, polled purebred daughter of Wulfs Xcellsior X252X out of Teacake 7523T for \$14,000.

Capps also bought the next two high-selling heifers. Wulfs Darcy 6107D, a 3/5/16 red, homozygous polled Lim-Flex 75% daughter of Wulfs Aerosmith 9556A out of Miss Wulfette 0535X brought \$13,500.

Wulfs Deniz 6202D ET, a 2/19/16 red, homozygous polled purebred daughter of Wulfs Xtractor X233X out of Three Rivers 7317T was purchased by Capps for \$12,250.
